

### Aluminium Orangeries

With the use of strong 40mm box rafters, our Aluminium orangeries boast a slim, elegant roof profile with excellent thermal performance. Extra strong rafters mean the tie bars can be set higher, guaranteeing increased headroom as well as a contemporary, understated finish. Even in large buildings, the roof structure remains remarkably minimal, creating a sense of clear, free space under the eaves.

All Aluminium exterior coloured profiles are quality finished with powder coat paint. This coating can be chosen from any colour within the RAL spectrum, enabling you to personalise your orangery to marry in with the existing colour pallet of your home.



#### Traditional Lantern Orangeries

The traditional lantern orangery depicts the classic and original orangery style, whereby a glazed lantern roof light is set into a traditional flat roof, created using timber ceiling joists. The Aluminium lantern is slimline in appearance and brings a stylish ambience to your orangery or extension, whilst maximising the amount of natural light coming into your home.

With the additional benefit of powder coating, these lanterns can be created in an array of colours. Whilst white, anthracite and black come as standard, we can also create all our Aluminium products in almost any profile from the RAL colour spectrum, enabling you to marry your build into the existing colour pallet of your home or alternatively, go for something a bit different!

### uPVC Orangeries

Our uPVC orangery roof-system consist of a strong, slim line Aluminium core based structure, capped with uPVC. This capping enables the added choice of decorative gutter fascia and external cornice detailing, creating an attractive, eye-catching finish.

uPVC orangeries can be created in a selection of heritage colours and woodgrain effects, allowing you to choose the perfect finish to compliment your home. # GLAZED EXTENSION BUILDING AND DESIGN

Glazed extensions are becoming ever more popular with our customers. The added benefit of a solid roof and plastered ceiling allows for the addition of light fittings and gives a substantial feel to the build. This married with selected areas of roof glass, gives the perfect natural light input with a warm and cosy feel.

The benefit of lightweight, synthetic roof tiles is that they're light enough to sit on conservatory frames, as well as being extremely thermally efficient and fully compliant with building regulations. Many of our customers also opt for brick, block or stonework finishes to marry in with the existing medium of their property.

## GLAZED EXTENSION MATERIAL CHOICES

### **Synthetic Tiled Roofs**

As with all our builds, the desired finish of your glazed extension is created individually for you and to marry in with your property. Our synthetic roof tiles come in several different colour choices and the glass can be inputted in many different ways, depending on which roof design you choose.

Your tiled roof can sit on conservatory frames or a more substantial stone or brick build, with windows and doors chosen to suit your requirements and property style. For more information on material and colour choices, please see our conservatory, window and door sections.





### **Panelled Roofs**

Panelled roofs are the first roofing systems designed to allow you to combine interior plastered ceilings with shaped panelled glazing. Internally, similar to our uPVC orangery roof systems, these roofs include a perimeter ceiling pelmet in order to place spotlights and if desired, music speakers.

Externally, the panels are finished in urban grey, blending in with virtually any house style. As with synthetic tiled roofs, your panelled roof can sit on conservatory frames or a more substantial stone or brick build. A contemporary glazed extension with unique style and finish.


